Int'l gold medalist runs for kids' causes

30 June 2024. Bemedaled police athlete Police Master Sergeant Miguelito Carranza is set to conquer two prestigious mountain trail races for two very relevant causes come August (in Italy) and September (in Switzerland).

Dubbed as "Mission 315: Running with a Purpose", Carranza, together with The Aduyon Project, aims to raise funds for young learners with special needs enrolled at the Itogon Central School and kids needing long-term medical attention under the care of Hands of God Charity.

Carranza, a World Police and Fire Games gold medalist, will participate in the 145km Sur les Traces des Ducs de Savoie (TDS) and the 170km Ultra Trail Monte Rosa (UTMR) — for a total of 315 km (thus the mission is so-named).
